

**Launceston Historical Society Inc.
Primary History Prize 2021
Grade 4**

PRIZES: 1 x \$75 book voucher in each grade. 2 x \$45 book voucher in each grade

THE TOPIC:

The judging criteria will concentrate on historical research skills and methods rather than topic or technical presentation.

Students have a free choice of topics so that the task fits into the class program. However, where curriculum and class planning permits, LHS encourages students to choose topics related to the history of Launceston, Tasmania or Australia. Some suggestions are: person, place, object or family history.

THE TASK:

Choose a topic from the historical period within the grade curriculum.

Research the topic using historical research methodologies.

Present the findings as an A3 poster or a project using word/publisher or PowerPoint (hard copies only).

JUDGING CRITERIA: (in order of importance)

1. Concentrate on historical facts and accuracy, this is the most important aspect.
2. The originality and uniqueness of topic.
3. **Evidence of at least 3 different types of information sources.**
4. Acknowledgement of sources (written on back).
5. Language accuracy and visual presentation.

ENTRY GUIDELINES:

- **Posters no larger than A3 size.**
- **Projects no more than 6 pages.**
- **Hard copies only.**

Please write student's name and grade on the bottom right hand corner of the front page.

Fix the entry form securely to the back of the project; taped rather than stapled.

Entries to be submitted by 15 October 2021.
